Guidelines for All India short video competition

1. Theme for world TB day 2022 is : Invest to End TB.
2. Video must be between 5-8 minutes in length and must be original work.
3. Competition is open for MBBS (Including interns) students from Govt. and private medical colleges located in India.
4. The video can be shot with any device but minimum resolution permitted is 480p to 780 p. No video from flash, cartoon powerpoint or slideshow software allowed.
5. Language preferably Hindi or English . If any other National language used , caption in English must be provided.
6. The video may not contain any mention, discussion, logo, trademark, service mark, storefront, trade dress , mascot, photograph or other image of any company or website.
7. The video must not infringe upon the rights of any third party, including , without limitation , copyright, trademark and rights of publicity and privacy. Video must be suitable for everyone and may not be violent, immoral, offensive illegal , orographic, obscene, indecent or similarly inappropriate.
8. Video must not be submitted anywhere else for competition and to video streaming websites.
9. The video to be uploaded on google drive and link of the video to be shared along with application form duly filled, signed and stamped from HOD Community Medicine or Principal of respective Medical College on this email id. (info@healthandfamily.in , copy to healthandfamilyindia@gmail.com) by 5th March 2020 upto 6 pm. Note: Do not upload to any video playback portals like YouTube etc.)
10. By submitting the video in the competition, each entrant represents and warrants that these requirements have been met . Failure to satisfy these requirements may result in ineligibility with respect to all video submitted by or on behalf of that entrant institution.
11. There is a limit of maximum of 10 video per college and one per team.
12. The judging of the video will be done by a central committee based upon contents, presentation, impact, likes and views.
13. Date of starting registration is 20 th Feb 2022 , Date of closing 5th March 2022, Date of video uploads on YouTube 6th to 10th march 2022, open for public view from 11th March to 18 th March 2022, judging from 19th March to 23rd March 2022 and result deceleration on 24th March 2022.
14. Video submitted will be used by IAPSM as well other collaborating units for awareness at various levels.
15. Prizes to be won -1st prize (Cash reward of Rs.10000), 2nd prize (cash reward of Rs. 5000)3rd prize (Certificate of appreciation).
