# About Lucknow

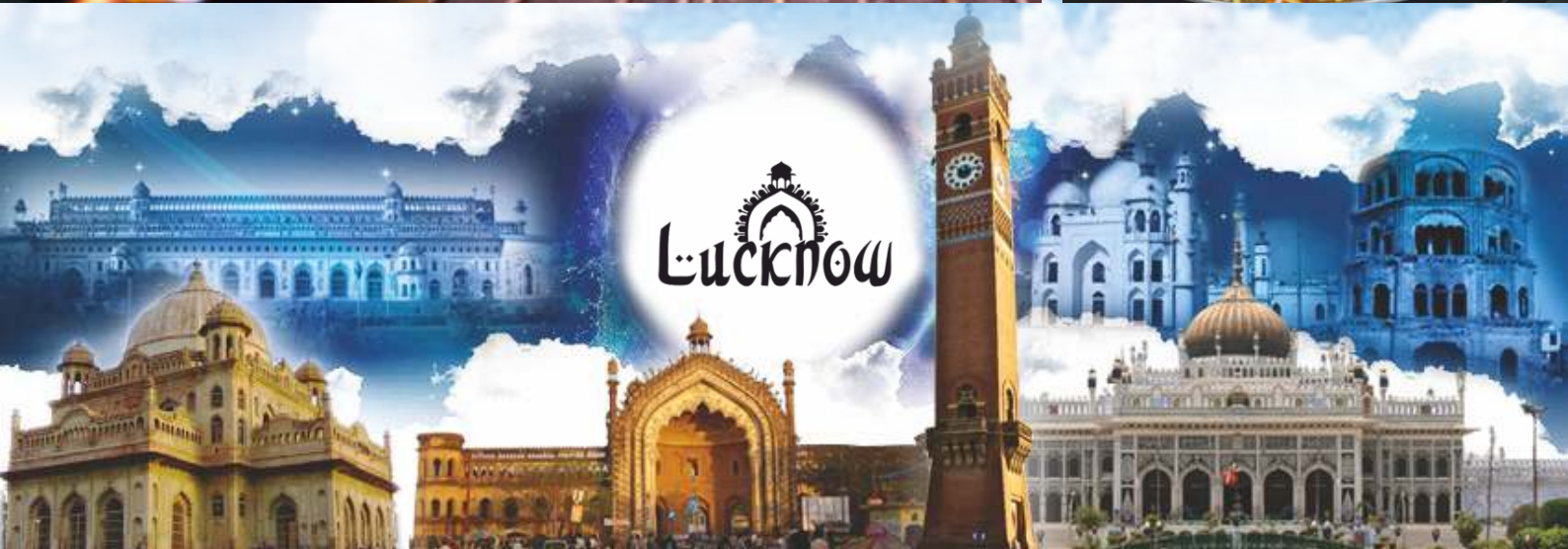

**ABOUT THE WORKSHOP:** KVAFSU-CVA Rabies Diagnostic Laboratory, a World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) Reference Laboratory for rabies, at Veterinary College, KVAFSU, Bengaluru is the 1<sup>st</sup> WOAH Reference Lab for rabies in South Asia and the 12<sup>th</sup> at the global level. This laboratory in collaboration with WOAHRRAP (WOAH Regional Representation for Asia and the Pacific) Commonwealth Veterinary Association (CVA) and National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), Govt. of India has been providing the hands on training on rabies diagnosis in South Asia for strengthening diagnosis of rabies in animals since 2013.

The current workshop is planned with an objective of "Sensitization and Strengthening rabies diagnosis and surveillance in animals." This practically oriented, real time workshop will be focusing on latest developments in rabies diagnostics, surveillance, including the most user friendly, simple, rapid 'Occipital Foramen' based brain sampling, its' packing, transportation, processing, preservation, and basic diagnostic techniques such as Monoclonal antibody based lateral flow assay(LFA), direct fluorescent antibody technique(DFA), Direct Rapid Immunohistochemistry Test (dRIT) and Polymerase Chain reaction (One step PCR).
