*Human-related factors include the results of industrialization and expansion of communities to accommodate the global population explosion. Developmental progress with clearing of forests for new roads, residences, towns, and farmlands impinge on wildlife ecology. Moreover, human intrusion on animal ecosystem is influenced by globalization of trade, alteration of farming and food chain practices, increased hunting and pet ownership, ecotourism, and expansion of culinary practice. Human exposures to animals and wildlife may be affected by changes in political regimes, conflict and wars, famine, mass migration and loosening of border controls, and breakdown of public health infrastructure. Furthermore, starvation and nutritional deficiencies usually result in a highly susceptible population to various diseases, including infections transmitted directly or indirectly from animal.*
